U-polynomial, Thickets, Electrical networks and Statistical optimalities

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Problem 1 Given m vertices and n edges, construct a graph with minimal number of cocycles and maximal number of spanning trees. (Construct a matroid on n elements with minimal number of cocircuits and maximal number of bases)

The object of this talk is to explain the motivation behind this problem and show some possible avenues of research.

One way of counting cocycles is given by the U-polynomial defined by Noble and Welsh. Part of the talk would present this polynomial and explain its importance in trying to solve the cocircuit-basis problem.
